- Enormous Lobbying Expenditures: In the first nine months of 2009, Comcast spent \$13.4 million on 98 lobbyists in Washington to lock down its control of the Internet and fight for anti-consumer laws.

- Fewer Choices: Comcast would have unprecedented control over what you can watch and how you can watch it. They'll suffocate your ability to watch TV online and make it even harder to find alternative voices on cable.
- Higher Prices: Comcast is notorious for price gouging. Over the past five years, Comcast raised its basic cable rates nearly 50 percent in some areas. Even if you don't have Comcast, you could end up paying more to get NBC shows.
- More Mergers: If this goes through, it could set off a wave of mega-deals across the media landscape, as other companies try to keep up with Comcast.
